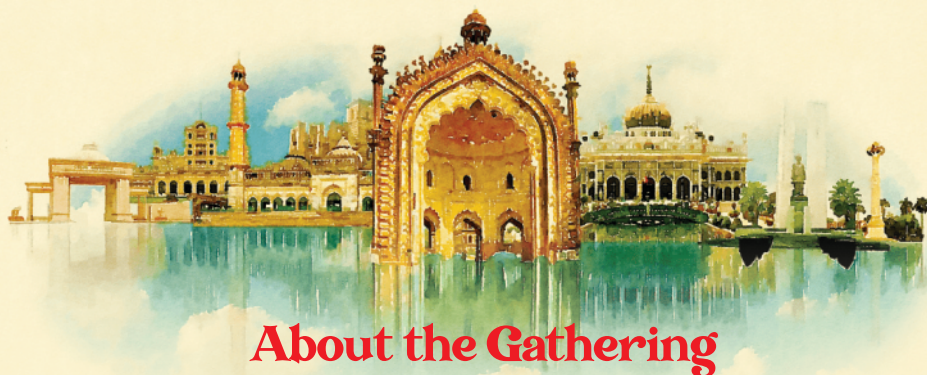
About the Lucknow

- Animal Behavior and Comparative Psychology

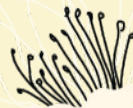

Abstracts should be submitted online for oral or poster presentation. Abstract should be submitted in MS Word not exceeding 250 words. Abstract should be unstructured, within single paragraph.

Font: Times New Roman, Text should be justified (single spacing, margin: L2", R1"). Title: Capital and bold with font size 14, Author's Name: Bold with font size 12.

Affiliation: Address of institution with e-mail ID of corresponding author only. Presenting author should be underlined. Title, Authors' name and Affiliation should be centre aligned.

Key words: 4-5 words in Italics, bold with font size 10.

The size of the poster should be 3 ft (W) × 4 ft (H) [Portrait mode]
