4. The Practice

● **Restricted entry of automobile-** The nonrenewable fuel vehicles are not permitted in the campus. These vehicles are to be parked outside the college. A guard is also there to check that no vehicles can cross into the boundary of college. This practice makes the college pollution free and eco-friendly campus. Also, this is a security measures that mandatory to be followed by the students as well as anyone entering in the college campus.

● **Ban on use of Plastic-** The college campus is about to free from the use of plastic. Single use plastic like cups, bottles, plastic bags, spoons etc. have been avoid to use by the students as well as faculties. Some of the display messages of avoidance of plastic have been tagged at student's frequent places.

● **Landscaping with trees and plants-** The institute has a proper canopy of trees and plants throughout of its pathway of pedestrian. This gives a beautiful look to the college campus with pollution free environment. Gardeners have been appointed for taking care and watering of these trees time to time. Every year plantation program is done by our students, faculty and staff under the initiative and supervision of environmental committee. In spite of above, the institute is taking initiative for paperless department. Internal communication is done through email or e-message. E-notice board is also created to convey the day-to-day information to staff members. Electronic gadgets are preferred to store and transfer of official data. All the departments as well as examination section and library are equipped with latest technology computers to do the paperless work.

● **Energy Conservation:** Use of LED bulbs/ power efficient equipment- The institute is completely renovated in the year 2018. The traditional power sources have been replaced by LED bulbs. College balconies, staff room, girl's common room, conference room, principal chamber, administrative office etc. places light sources have switched to new LED bulbs with roof ceiling. This replacement gave a complete professional look to the college infrastructure. The policy on energy conservation highlights on developing a proactive and progressive approach to providing energy efficient, responsible, and cost-effective operations on campus. LED lighting, false ceilings to reduce heat load, as well as abundant natural light makes the building energy efficient.

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6. Problems Encountered and Resources Required:

While carrying out this practice, the following problems are encountered by the college:

- College needs to take initiates for installing solar panels, installing automatic switches for saving electricity, equipment for measuring air quality and recycling machines.
- In summer season, we have to face lot of water scarcity. Hence in order to meet requirements we need to hire water tankers.

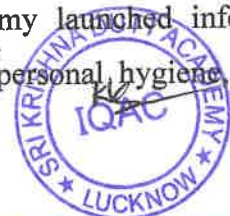
Key Initiatives:
