



MINUTES OF THE GRIEVANCE & REDRESSAL COMMITTEE MEETING:

A meeting of G&R committee members was held on 25.09.2021 at 2.00 pm in administrative office. Following members were present for the meeting:

Minutes:

The Grievance & Redressal Committee meeting commenced at 2:00 pm in the Administrative Office of the college.

Based on the several grievances received via phone from parents to all teachers regarding safety and health issues, the committee acknowledged the seriousness of these concerns and emphasized the need for comprehensive planning and adherence to established protocols to ensure the safety and well-being of the college community. There was urgency to bring to discussion about concerns raised. These concerns underscored the importance of visualizing and implementing all efforts in accordance with government guidelines. The meeting was called to order by Dr. Anshul Pant, who provided an update on the current COVID-19 situation as per government instructions. The update

included information on local infection rates, vaccination status, and specific concerns related to the college community. Following measures to be taken were discussed in the meeting:

1. Health and Safety Protocols:

Mandatory Masks: All students, faculty, and staff must wear masks while on campus premises.

Hand Hygiene: Provide hand sanitization stations at entrances, classrooms, and common areas. Encourage frequent hand washing with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.

Respiratory Etiquette: Promote covering mouth and nose with a tissue or elbow when coughing or sneezing.

Physical Distancing: Maintain a minimum of 6 feet distance between individuals in classrooms, laboratories, libraries, and other areas.

Regular Disinfection: Ensure thorough and frequent cleaning and disinfection of classrooms, desks, chairs, door handles, and other frequently touched surfaces.

2. Screening and Monitoring:

Temperature Checks: Conduct daily temperature screenings at entry points for students, faculty, and staff.

Symptom Monitoring: Encourage self-monitoring amongst students and teachers for symptoms such as fever, cough, difficulty breathing, and advise staying home if feeling unwell.

COVID-19 Testing: Coordinate with health authorities to facilitate testing and Always keeping the Isolation Room operational for immediate requirement.

3. Academic and Operational Adjustments:

Hybrid Learning: Consider hybrid models combining offline and online classes to reduce the density of students on campus and prevent any unavoidable conditions in campus.

Flexible Attendance Policies: Implement flexible attendance policies to accommodate students and staff who may need to stay home due to health concerns like offline as well as offline attendance record.

Staggered Schedules: If there is need to prevent crowding at a time Implement staggered arrival and departure times to minimize crowding at entry and exit points.

4. Communication and Education:

Awareness Campaigns: Conduct regular awareness campaigns in form of banners and also in the what's app groups of the students on COVID-19 prevention measures, symptoms, and actions to take if feeling unwell.

Training: Provide training to faculty, staff, and students on health protocols and procedures to follow on campus.

5. Facilities and Infrastructure:

Ventilation: Ensure adequate ventilation in classrooms and common areas to improve air circulation.

Signage: Install signage throughout the campus to remind individuals about physical distancing, (like making circles at a distance of 2 metre) mask-wearing, hand hygiene, and other safety measures.

Facility Readiness: Prepare isolation rooms or areas for individuals who develop symptoms while on campus.

6. Mental Health Support:

Counseling Services: Offer accessible counseling and mental health support services for students and staff dealing with anxiety and stress related to COVID-19.

7. Monitoring:

Feedback Mechanism: Establish a feedback mechanism for students, faculty, and staff to report concerns and suggestions related to COVID-19 safety measures.


8. Review and Adaptation:

Regular Review: Continuously review and update the guidelines based on evolving public health recommendations and local COVID-19 transmission trends.

These guidelines are made with aim to create a safe and supportive environment for all members of the college community while mitigating the risks associated with COVID-19. However, Adjustments would be made as per specific directives and requirements from Indian authorities and health experts.

The committee agreed to monitor the COVID-19 situation closely and convene as needed to adjust plans in accordance with government directives and health guidelines. The meeting concluded at 3:00 pm with a clear understanding of the current COVID-19 landscape and a commitment to ensuring a safe environment for all members of the college community.

उपरोक्त विषयक उच्च शिक्षा अनुभाग-3 के आदेश संख्या-891/सत्तर-3-2021-08 (20)/2020, दिनांक 23, मार्च, 2021 के अनुक्रम में गृह (गोपन) अनुभाग-3 के पत्र संख्या-600/2021-सौएक्स-3, दिनांक 26, मार्च, 2021 की छायाप्रति संलग्न कर प्रेषित करते हुए मुझे यह कहने का निदेश हुआ है कि कोविड-19 के बढ़ते संक्रमण के दृष्टिगत माह अप्रैल में प्रदेश स्थित विश्वविद्यालय/महाविद्यालय/उच्च शिक्षण संस्थान के संचालन विषयक निर्णय, सम्बन्धित कुलपति की सरसुति पर जिलाधिकारी द्वारा स्थानीय परिस्थितियों को ध्यान में रखते हुए लिये जायेंगे। यदि स्थलीय परिस्थितियों के दृष्टिगत कुलपति एवं जिलाधिकारी द्वारा किसी शिक्षण संस्थान को किसी अवधि के लिए भौतिक रूप से बन्द करने का निर्णय लिया जाता है, तो वह निम्न शर्तों के अधीन होगा:-

चिन्हित कन्टेनमेन्ट जोन के भीतर स्वास्थ्य एवं परिवार कल्याण मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार द्वारा निर्धारित किए गए उपायों को निम्नानुसार सुनिश्चित करना होगा :-

Subject: Guidelines regarding running of universities/colleges/higher educational institutions in view of the increasing infection of COVID-19.

Sir,

In continuation of the order number-891/seventy-3-2021-08 (20)/2020, dated March 23, 2021 of Higher Education Section-3 on the above mentioned subject, letter number-600/2021-CX of Home (Confidentiality) Section-3. -3. Attaching the photocopy of the letter dated March 26, 2021, I am instructed to say that in view of the increasing infection of Covid-19, the decision regarding the operation of the university/college/higher educational institution located in the state in the month of April, related to A) Sulapati On the recommendation of the District Magistrate, it will be taken keeping in mind the local circumstances. If, in view of the local conditions, a decision is taken by the Vice-Chancellor and the District Magistrate to physically close an educational institution for a period, then it will be so subject to the following conditions:

1. During the stipulated period at the local level, classes/teaching work will be conducted online and not in the institute premises.
2. In those institutions where examinations/practical examinations are going on, the scheduled examinations/practical examinations will be conducted as per the schedule. Strict compliance with the Covid-19 SOP (Standard Operating Procedure) issued from time to time, mandatory use of masks, maintaining physical distance, sanitization of the premises and other guidelines will always be ensured-
 - (1) Appropriate measures will be taken to encourage the desired behavior/action related to Covid-19 and to strictly follow the standards of cleanliness and social distancing of the elephant wearing the antidote.
 - (2) The university/college/educational institution should be completely sanitized before every shift of the examination.
 - (3) Along with social distancing in universities/college/educational institutions was ensured that students are given entry only after washing/hand sanitizing. Go. If there is more than one entrance in the institute, ensure their use.

- (4) Arrangement of queue should be ensured for the people coming in and out of the premises in which a special sign should be made at a distance of six feet.
- (5) Instead of biometric attendance, alternative arrangements should be made for contactless attendance.
- (6) It will be mandatory for all officers/employees in the institute to wear masks. For this, additional quantity of masks should be kept available in advance.
- (7) Compliance with social distancing should be ensured by making students sit at a distance of 06 feet in the class room.
- (8) Teachers/students/personnel should be made aware to avoid coughing or sneezing into handkerchief/tissue paper or elbow and touching the face, eyes, mouth, nose and ears.
- (9) Availability of necessary equipment like gloves, face cover/mask, hand soap etc. should be ensured for the cleaning staff/personnel.
- (10) The university/university/educational institution should ensure arrangements for sanitizer, handwash, thermal scanning and first aid before every shift of the examination. If any student or teacher or other student has symptoms of cough, cold or fever, they should be given first aid and sent back home. If symptoms of Covid appear in students and staff, they should be immediately tested and recording of results should be ensured.
- (11) If a student in a university/college/educational institution gets infected with Corona, then the university/college/educational institution should ensure that the protocol issued by the Medical and Health Department of Uttar Pradesh is followed in letter and spirit.
- (12) Students/teachers should be encouraged to share food and utensils with others. All in institutions to avoid
- (13) In the University/College/Educational Institution, no outside vendor should be allowed to sell any food item near the premises or at the entry gate/point.

Apart from the above, strict compliance of the Stay-Track-Treat protocol/vaccination mentioned in the attached letter dated 26.03.2021 of Home (Confidentiality) Section-3 along with the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India on 3.03.2021 will be ensured.

Sir,

For effective control of COVID-19, guidelines have been issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, by Order No. 40-3/ 2020-DM-J (A), dated 23.03.2021.

- (2) It is to be informed that after a continuous decline in the number of people infected with Covid-19 for 05 months, now the number of infected people has been increasing continuously for the last few weeks. In such a situation, a series of condensation of pandemic is required to restore normalcy. Need to break effectively. Prior order of Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India dated 27.01. 2021, all economic and other activities will be resumed in a phased manner with the guidelines issued by 2011 opened with the condition that the prescribed Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) is carefully followed. To carry out the above activities successfully, there is an essential need to strictly implement the Test-Track-Treat protocol in all parts of the country, completely follow the COVID-19 protocol and rapidly expand the vaccination campaign.
3. In this regard, I am directed to say that for effective complete control on the spread of Covid-19, there is a mandatory need to implement the following guidelines from 01.04.2021 to 30.04.2021 and ensure their compliance: -

Effective implementation of digestive test track treat protocol

Test

- 1- The tests being conducted for Covid-19 should be done equally in all the districts and in the districts where more number of cases are reported, adequate tests should be conducted in more numbers. With better efforts, the ratio of RT-PCR tests should be increased to 70 percent or more.



track
New Covid positive cases found as a result of intensive testing should be immediately quarantined and the people who came in contact with them should be traced and quarantined as soon as possible. Containment zones should be demarcated and prescribed prevention measures should be implemented in these areas.

- 3- Effective demarcation of containment zones in sensitive and high incidence areas is an effective way to prevent and control the spread of the virus. The demarcation of the containment zone will be done by the district administration at the micro level keeping in mind the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India. The list of containment zones should be made available on the website by the coordinating District Magistrate. Besides, this list should also be shared regularly with the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India.
- 4- Within the identified containment zones, containment measures prescribed by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India have to be ensured as follows:
 - (1) Only essential activities should be allowed in the containment zone.
 - (2) Complete ban on movement of people in and outside the containment zone should be ensured, except for emergency medical care, supply of essential goods and services.
 - (3) For this purpose, intensive monitoring should be done from house to house by surveillance teams.
 - (4) Testing should be done as per the prescribed protocol.
 - (5) A list of people who have come in contact with people suffering from Covid should be prepared and along with their tracking and identification, they should be quarantined for 14 days (80 percent of the people who came in contact should be traced and listed within 72 hours) .
 - (6) Surveillance of ILI/SARI cases in buffer zones should be done through health facilities or outreach mobile units or fever clinics.
 - (7) It will be the responsibility of the district administration, police and municipal officials at the local level to ensure that the prescribed containment standards are followed should be strictly followed.

5. Rapid isolation of COVID-19 patients should be ensured with treatment facilities (home isolation guidelines should be strictly followed).
6. Clinical interventions should be made available as per instructions.
7. Capacity building of health workers and experienced persons should be done on a continuous basis at all levels.
8. Practice should be conducted to ensure that the prescribed clinical management protocols are clearly understood and managed accordingly. The concerned agencies of the state will ensure that the availability of dedicated health and logistics (including dispensaries) for Covid is adequate. For effective control and prevention of infection, infection treatment facilities (prevention and control) should be followed by health workers and experienced persons.

Expected conduct in relation to Covid-19:

- 9- All necessary measures should be implemented to encourage expected conduct/action related to Covid-19 and strict adherence to the standards of wearing masks, hand hygiene and social distancing should be ensured.
- 10- Wearing a face mask is an essential preventive measure and administrative action should be taken to enforce this basic requirement. In view of the necessity of wearing masks, requisite fines and other administrative actions were also taken against persons not wearing masks in public and workplaces.
- 11- To ensure compliance with social distancing in crowded places, especially markets, weekly markets, public transport etc., the SOP issued by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India should be strictly followed.

12. The SOP issued earlier for the purpose of controlling journeys by vehicle, train and metro rail, aircraft should be strictly followed. Strict compliance with the Covid protocol should also be ensured regarding buses, boats or other means of transport.
13. The National directives for COVID-19 Management which is annexed. as enclosed, should be strictly followed.

Following the SOP issued for various activities-

14. Almost all types of economic and other activities have been started in a phased manner outside the containment zone. These activities mainly include travel by passenger trains, domestic air travel, metro rail, schools, higher educational institutions, hotels and restaurants, shopping malls, multiplexes, amusement parks, yoga centers and gyms, exhibitions, meetings and conventions etc. and for their operation there are functional Standards (SOP) have been set.
15. The concerned departments will be responsible for strictly implementing the SOP (SOP) updated from time to time for prevention and control of the spread of Covid-19.

Vaccination

16. The Government of India has launched the world's largest vaccination campaign against Covid-19. In this context, the National Expert Group on Vaccine Administration for COVID-19 (NEGVAC) provides guidance on population groups, procurement and inventory management, vaccine selection, distribution and tracking. The recommendations of NEOVAC have been accepted and finalized by the Central Government.
17. Although the vaccination campaign is progressing smoothly, the slow pace of vaccination is a matter of concern. In such a situation, the pace of vaccination should be accelerated in a planned manner to break the Covid-19 chain in the current scenario.

Local restrictions

18. Based on the assessment of the situation, local restrictions can be imposed at the district/area city/ward level.
19. There will be no restriction on interstate and intrastate movement of persons and goods etc. Cross border transportation will be allowed as per the terms of treaties made with neighboring countries. There will be no need for separate permission/approval/e-permit for this. of any kind from

Protection of persons vulnerable to infection

20. Persons above 65 years of age, persons suffering from co-morbidity i.e. more than 1 other disease, pregnant women and children below 10 years of age are advised to take necessary precautions.

Use of Arogya Setu mobile application

21. Arogya Setu app should be used in compatible mobile phones. Arogya Setu App helps in identifying the risk of early infection and protecting the individual and community against infection.

Provides security. Strict compliance with guidelines

22. All officers will ensure strict compliance with the above guidelines and will use Section 144 CrPC-1973 as necessary to strictly comply with social distancing.
