- A book review's length may vary from a single paragraph to a sub-thousand-word essay.

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

सेमिनार रिपोर्ट

दिनांक : 24 सितम्बर 2022

प्रो० सी० बी० शर्मा जी ने अपने उद्बोधन में स्पष्ट किया कि राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति-2020 पूरी शिक्षा व्यवस्था में सुधार और पुनर्गठन का प्रस्ताव करती है ताकि इसका इकीसर्वीं सदी की शिक्षा के आकांक्षात्मक लक्ष्यों के साथ मेल तो बिठाया ही जा सके, साथ ही इसे प्राचीन भारतीय ज्ञान परम्परा और सांस्कृतिक मूल्यों की विरासत की नींव पर समृद्ध भी बनाया जा सके। शिक्षा नीति कहती है कि दुनिया के विभिन्न विकसित देशों के अनुभवों से यह स्पष्ट हो चुका है कि अपनी भाषा, संस्कृति और परंपराओं में सुशिक्षित होने से हानि नहीं बल्कि शैक्षिक, सामाजिक और तकनीकी उन्नति के लिए लाभ ही मिला है। इसी संदर्भ में, राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति-2020 ने भारत के सभी छात्र-छात्राओं द्वारा अच्छे, सफल, मौलिक सोच वाले, परिस्थिति अनुकूल और रचनाशील व्यक्ति बनने के लिए जिन मुख्य विषयों, कौशलों व क्षमताओं को आवश्यक माना है उसमें 'भारत का ज्ञान' एक मुख्य विषय है। राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति-2020, 'भारत के ज्ञान' को परिभाषित करते हुए कहती है कि "भारत के ज्ञान" में प्राचीन भारत से प्राप्त ज्ञान और आधुनिक भारत और इसकी सफलताओं और चुनौतियों में इसके योगदान के साथ ही शिक्षा, स्वास्थ्य, पर्यावरण आदि के संबंध में भारत की भविष्य की आकांक्षाओं का एक स्पष्ट भाव शामिल होगा।

प्रो० यू० सी० वशिष्ठ ने भी वक्तव्य में बहुत ही महत्वपूर्ण बिन्दुओं पर प्रकाश डालते हुए स्पष्ट किया कि भारतीय ज्ञान परम्परा से कोई भी पहलू अछूता नहीं हैं वो योग, दर्शन, चिकित्सा, आयुर्वेद, एवं आधुनिक विज्ञान ही क्यों न हो। प्रो० यू० सी० वशिष्ठ ने बताया कि प्राचीन भारत ने दर्शन, ध्वन्यात्मक भाषा विज्ञान, अनुष्ठान, व्याकरण, खगोल विज्ञान, अर्थशास्त्र, सांख्य सिद्धांत, तर्क, जीवन विज्ञान, आयुर्वेद, ज्योतिष एवं संगीत जैसे विभिन्न मानव जाति की उन्नति में अत्याधिक योगदान दिया है।

प्राचीन भारतीयों द्वारा आविष्कृत विचारों और तकनीकियों का आधुनिक विज्ञान और प्रौद्योगिकी की मूलाधार को दृढ़ करने में अद्भुत योगदान रहा है। जबकि इन अभिनव योगदान को वर्तमान में कुछ तो अपनाया जा रहा है, कुछ अभी भी अज्ञात है।

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उपनिषद् यद्यपि ज्ञानकाण्ड है, जिसमें आध्यात्मिक जीवन का प्रतिपादन किया गया है, तथापि साधारण मनुष्यों को कर्म करने चाहिए इसका भी उल्लेख उपनिषदों से प्राप्त होता है। तैत्तिरीयोपनिषद् में नीतिबोध का रूप अधिक स्पष्ट रूप से उपलब्ध होता है।

प्राचीन वेदों और अन्य शास्त्रों में चिकित्सा प्रणालियों का भी उल्लेख मिलता है। चरक संहिता और सुश्रुत संहिता 700 औषधियों जड़ी बूटियों के साहित्य के मुख्य पारम्परिक संग्रह हैं।

विश्व धरोहर के लिए इन समृद्ध विरासतों को न केवल भावी पीढ़ी के लिए पोषित और संरक्षित किया जाना चाहिए बल्कि हमारी शिक्षा प्रणाली के जरिए इन्हें बढ़ाना चाहिए और इन्हें नये उपयोग में लाना चाहिए।

इस सेमिनार का उद्देश्य राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति-2020 के आलोक में हमारी प्राचीनतम् भारतीय ज्ञान, विरासत, परंपरा एवं शिक्षण पद्धतियों के सनातन मुल्यों को आधुनिक शैक्षणिक पद्धति व व्यवस्था में अभिसिंचित करना है। भारतीय ज्ञान परंपरा तो वैदिक एवं उपनिषद काल में थी, वह बौद्ध और जैन काल में भी रही, विभिन्न विश्वविद्यालयों की स्थापना और शिक्षा व्यवस्था से स्पष्ट परिलक्षित होता है। लेकिन इसका लोप विगत 200 से 300 वर्षों में हुआ है। इस राष्ट्रीय रूपरेखा में इसे भी उचित रूप में प्रतिगिंगित करने का आवश्यकता है।
