Expert instructors demonstrated effective strategies to escape potentially dangerous situations.

Self defense training techniques instills self confidence amongst students, the head trainer from the Warriors, spoke largely on the kind of violence that is committed against women. He narrated some instances related to Domestic Violence, Dowry, Cruelty by husband & in-laws, Sexual Harassment in public, private, or the workplace, Stalking, Obscene Calls that comes to the Special Police Unit for assistance. He pointed out why it is necessary to attend and train oneself with this kind of workshop and training programmes. He said that having knowledge about self-defense techniques not only helps defend but also it builds confidence in oneself. He gave advice and tips to the students on how to avoid situations and circumstances that may lead to unwanted/untoward incidents.

The workshop on self-defense proved to be a resounding success, equipping individuals with both physical skills and a heightened sense of awareness. Empowering participants to take an active role in



their personal safety, the workshop served as a valuable resource in building a safer and more confident community. As the lessons learned resonate, the impact of this workshop is expected to extend far beyond its duration, contributing to a culture of self-reliance and security. Participants engaged in handson activities, fostering a sense of confidence and preparedness. The workshop emphasized the importance of mental strength and quick decision-making in high-pressure scenarios. Attendees left with newfound awareness and practical skills, ready to enhance their personal safety. Overall, the workshop successfully instilled a sense of empowerment and equipped individuals with valuable tools for self-defense in various situations.

Attendees left with a heightened sense of self-efficacy and a better understanding of potential threats. The interactive nature of the workshop fostered a supportive environment, allowing participants to practice and refine their newly acquired skills. Overall, the event successfully equipped individuals with valuable tools to navigate and respond effectively to various situations, promoting a sense of empowerment and security. The training was given for a week and the female as well as the male students learnt the basics of self – defense.







The science department of Sri Krishna Dutt Academy organize a two-day Workshop on "The Chemistry of Early Life" 8, 9 November, 2019. The workshop aimed to enhance the knowledge of pupils about Chemistry of Early Life. Over two days, educators, pupil teachers & key note speakers converged to exchange insights and strategies.

Key Themes Discussed:

Explore the fascinating relationship between chemical reactions and language development in early childhood in an interactive workshop setting. Learn to recognize chemistry in children's everyday lives, find opportunities for age-appropriate chemical exploration, and create rich learning experiences through the topic of chemical reactions that teach the outcomes of the Early Years Learning Framework. The origin of life presents a particularly difficult problem for chemistry because it is essentially unconstrained: there are a very, very large number of reactions that might have occurred on peribiotic Earth, and few hard limits on the types of compounds that might have been available, on the possible reaction conditions, and on the processes that might finally have led to elementary cells of the type that we now know. What is, however, clear is the central conundrum of understanding "life": that is, that a living cell is composed of molecules; that molecules in cells are reacting; that neither the molecules nor the reactions are individually alive; but that the cell—as a collection of reactions and processes—is alive. Understanding how that transformation might have occurred—from an intractably large number of possible components, to an assembly of networks with an emergent property ("life"), is the central problem of the field, and one of the big problems in all of science.

The objectives of this research program are to develop an understanding of the plausible reactions that could occur on the peribiotic Earth.

We, thus, wish to:

i) constrain the problem to simplify and focus the task of other scientists who are interested in making the structurally complex molecules that are essential in current life;

- ii) attack some of the problems of concentration, catalysis, and network formation that are essential to the formation of spontaneously evolving, dissipative systems;
- iii) assemble plausible lists of elementary reactants and processes leading toward those commonly found in current metabolism;
- iv) develop rationales for the existence of "chemical fossils": that is, molecules, reactions, and processes that seem to be common to all life (so far as we know), and thus seem to offer hints about the very earliest, common, stages the formation of proto-cells.

Conclusion:

The workshop on "The Chemistry of Early Life" served as a platform for educators to engage in meaningful discussions, share innovative practices, and envision the future of athletes. By harnessing the power of technology, multisensory approaches, and inclusive strategies, educators are better equipped to create dynamic learning environments that empower all students to succeed.


