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### Report on One week Workshop on Self Defence

One-week Workshop on self defence from 18th September to 22th September 2018 was conducted at the Sri Krishna Dutt Academy from 02:00 pm to 04:00 pm. The workshop included various techniques such as Kickboxing, Tae-Kwon-do, Judo, Kung Fu, Karate, Krav Maga etc. The program observed the active participation and involvement of all students. The self-defense workshop conducted was an empowering event, equipping participants with essential skills and knowledge for personal safety. The session covered fundamental techniques such as situational awareness, basic strikes, and practical self-defense moves.

The program witnessed its pinnacle on the final day owing to the august gathering of the Chief Guest, The Warriors.

The workshop started off at 2 PM with an introduction where the trainers enlightened the students and shed light on the themes of 'Domestic Violence and Safe Journey'. Keeping in view the rising number of crimes in the country, it is important to provide self-defence training to them in the colleges to ensure their safety and security. Expert instructors demonstrated effective strategies to escape potentially dangerous situations.

Self defence training techniques instills self confidence amongst students, the head trainer from the Warriors, spoke largely on the kind of violence that is committed against women. He narrated some instances related to Domestic Violence, Dowry, Cruelty by husband & in-laws, Sexual Harassment in public, private, or the workplace, Stalking, Obscene Calls that comes to the Special Police Unit for assistance. He pointed out why it is necessary to attend and train oneself with this kind of workshop and training programmes. He said that having knowledge about self defence techniques not only helps defend but also it builds confidence in oneself. He gave advice and tips to the students on how to avoid situations and circumstances that may lead to unwanted/untoward incidents.

The workshop on self-defense proved to be a resounding success, equipping individuals with both physical skills and a heightened sense of awareness. Empowering participants to take an active role in their personal safety, the workshop served as a valuable resource in building a safer and more confident community. As the lessons learned resonate, the impact of this workshop is expected to extend far beyond its duration, contributing to a culture of self-reliance and security. Participants engaged in handson activities, fostering a sense of confidence and preparedness. The workshop emphasized the importance of mental strength and quick decision-making in high-pressure scenarios.
